## 1. Sentinel Tech High School Student Presentations

Her parents did not support her attendance at first. She did apply good effort the first year. With increased effort, a flexible schedule, and support from staff she did better and participated in CB Tech and Walla Walla Community College - Culinary School. Now she is just waiting for state assessment results to graduate. She thanked her parents, teachers, secretary, principal, superintendent, and school board.

#### 2. School Safety Report- Shelby Jensen

Shelby presented on year end discipline and safety data. She went over the numbers of students who were referred to various agencies and/or were on certain plans, discipline referrals, behvaior and safety plans, attendance contracts, CPS referrals, No self harm contracts, Merit referrals, bullying contracts, mental health participation. She also reminded the Board about the active shooter drill on June 9th.

Officer Harris presented the numbers of criminal complaints which he followed up on: 11 calls for Marijuana, 3 for suspicious, 1 abuse, 2 maliscious mischief, 4 harrassment, 2 theft, and 1 for indecent exposure. These numbers are lower because of his involvement with Grant Co., Shelby and other agencies.

Lorenzo also reported on his presentations with parents and his student work. He is in district Monday and Wednesday. He works with groups and individual students. He meets with them as well as does some work with break dancing.


