#### (3.b) MSSE 5th Grade Lunch Waste Project- Karl Edie

MSSE 5th Grade Lunch Waste Project - Karl Edie, Isaias Godinez and Emely Navarro shared with the Board the 5th grade Engineering Challenge. School lunch waste in our schools equaled 77 pounds of garbage a day. Collected data for an average per week of garbage. Presented the information to Mr. Edie and Mrs Hyndman with a solution to get reusable containers to put the leftovers in to give to a lunch helper to feed her pigs. Had a bake sale to purchase metal spoons and forks. They still need \$200 to buy metal bowls. Their hope is for the whole district will try to reduce trash.
