Who Qualifies?

• Current Kindergarten – 4th Graders who have received services through ELL, LAP, Title I, or Special Education and qualify for LAP or ELL services.

When and Where?

- July 13-31, 2020 (A 3-week program)
- At Home! Kits will be provided to you for all three weeks. Pick up will be at your child's school from 9-11 a.m. on Monday, July 13th. We can mail kits if this time does not work with your schedule.

What does it cost?

• At-Home Summer Enrichment Program is free for students, paid through state and federal grants.

What about supplies?

- Kits will be provided for all three weeks
- All supporting materials will be provided

Why should my child attend?

- Your child will enjoy the interactive kit activities, learn about the life cycle of plants, bees, and butterflies, and see how they are inter-connected. Lessons will provide a cultural component from the local Tulalip Tribes. Materials will also include research for inquiry-based learning that is appropriate for each age group. In addition, a reading and writing components will be incorporated into this unit of study as this is a grant requirement.
- Please commit to having your child participate in all three weeks! This is intentional instruction to help your student be academically prepared for the 2020-2021 school year.
