



Illini Central CUSD #189 is seeking 2 full-time, permanent Speech and Language Pathologists

We are a small, rural, district with about 700 students enrolled in pre-K through high school. Our district encompasses the communities of Easton, San Jose, and Mason City. The campus is located in Mason City which is with-in a 60 minute drive of Springfield, Bloomington, and Peoria. In this small district, we are able to build strong relationships with our colleagues, students, and families.

This is a great opportunity to work with a variety of students ages 3 - 21. We house most of the district under one roof with separate educational areas for grade school, middle school, and high school. Our Pre-K/ECE program is housed in another building on campus allowing for diverse experiences for SLPs. We offer relatively small caseloads (40 - 45 students typically) and encourage collaboration and utilization of the expertise the SLP has to offer. Flexible caseloads provide opportunities to trial innovative strategies and structures while working with a diverse population of students in the program and receiving support from the administration.
