Preparedness



# Drills

- Drills are held regularly to ensure we are prepared in the event of an emergency.
  - Fire
  - Earthquake
  - Lockdown
  - Intruder
- In the event of an emergency, Blackboard Connect will be utilized to give updated information. School phones may be set to voicemail.

# Campus Visitors

- Our front office will undergo safety upgrades in the summer of 2020.



# School Safety

- School administrators work with our School Resource Officer (SRO), who is a Rancho Cucamonga Police Officer assigned to our school. The SRO is contacted when there are situations or violations that require additional support or corrections.
- RMMS also works with the Interquest Program, which is a canine detection unit used to make sure there are no unsafe/illegal items brought to school.





# Student Safety

- RMMS staff is responsible for students while they are at school. You trust us to educate your children, watch over them, and to make sure they are safe at school
- Supervision before, during and after school is a top priority. Administration, proctors, staff, and crossing guards are highly visible and assigned to designated areas to maintain safety and order.

## Reporting Procedures

- Encourage your student to speak to an adult if there they are having an issue with another student or have a safety concern.
- Students can request an incident report from the office.
- Anonymous tips can be submitted through the school website.
- Call the office if your student is not willing or able to report for him/herself.

- All reported incidents are investigated and an appropriate plan of action and consequences are based on those findings.
