AVID's mission is to close the achievement gap by preparing all students for *college and career* readiness in a global society.

In the AVID Elective class, students will...

- Receive instruction in academic and social skills not targeted in other classes
- Focus on developing writing, reading, research, and speaking skills
- Learn organizational strategies, note-taking, and study techniques
- Develop critical thinking and inquiry skills
- Work on time management, goal setting, leadership, and collaboration skills
- Get academic help with in-class tutorials
- Be part of a positive peer group and a teacher support network that work collaboratively to help them be successful
- Participate in enrichment and motivational activities to make them college and career ready, including visiting colleges, exploring careers through guest speakers, resume writing, and interview skills
- Receive college exposure/knowledge (all grades) and assistance with college, financial aid, and scholarship applications (12th grade)

- It is designed to accelerate students into more rigorous classes.
- Offered as a one period class for grades 6-12 at Cedarcrest, MMS, Totem, MG, MP, and Legacy.
