**Reports**

1. Superintendent’s Report
  - a) December Board Meeting Reminder – The December regular board meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, December 27th which falls on an observed holiday, so the meeting will be available via Zoom and a physical location of Davis Elementary.
  - b) Reorganization Reminder- Mr. Fry reminded the board that December is the annual board organization meeting.
  - c) Classroom Visits - Superintendent Fry talked about his visits to classrooms across the three buildings in the past week and acknowledged the great work of the staff despite the many new and lingering challenges from the pandemic.
2. Principals Report
  - a) Davis: Principal Mark Ferraro shared about the many activities going on at Davis. The school is continuing to focus on gratitude with many school activities going on across the building. The Preschool/Transitional Kindergarten Thanksgiving celebration was a huge success!
  - b) Sager: Principal Susan Bell celebrated the great work of staff, Red Ribbon Week, the Deep Kindness book study of the staff, and the cross-curricular work of the 6th grade team around “Long Walk to Water”
  - c) CPHS: Principal Robert Aguilar talked about the upcoming “J Term” and the work of staff to create learning that engages students and acts as a hook and motivation for future learning. 3. Learning Assistant Program
