We will start the school year with several new staff in both buildings, including a full time Safety Director who will travel to both buildings. The district is very fortunate to have such dedicated, passionate, and knowledgeable staff who will make a tremendously positive impact on our students. The summer break has offered Old Fort Schools an opportunity to focus on infrastructure needs. The Elementary School is undergoing some enhancements to the front entrance and office area, which are completely funded with grant funds. A new electronic sign will be installed, which has been donated by a handful of sponsors. At the JH/HS building: new carpet was installed in the hallways, safety decals were added to the exterior doors, along with many other general maintenance improvements. The district purchased 4 new buses funded in part by state grant money. We are proud of the upgrades being made to the district and will continue to establish systems for future planning that is both financially responsible and with intentions of educating all students to their abilities.
