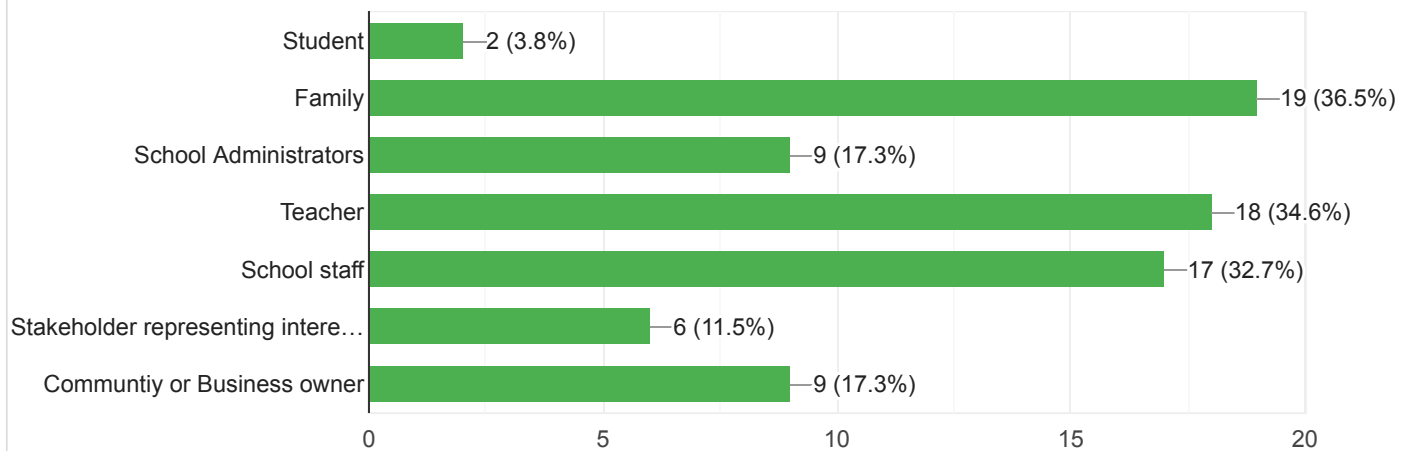

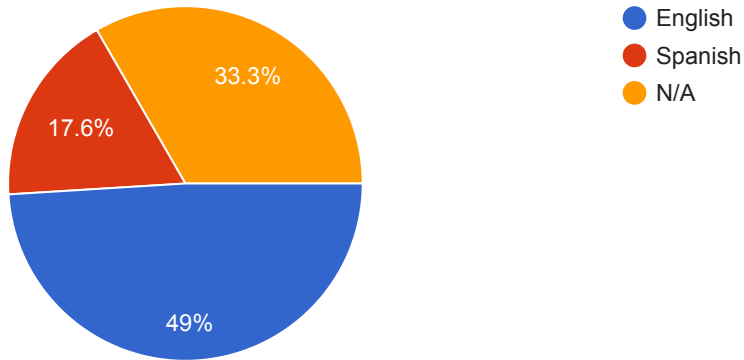

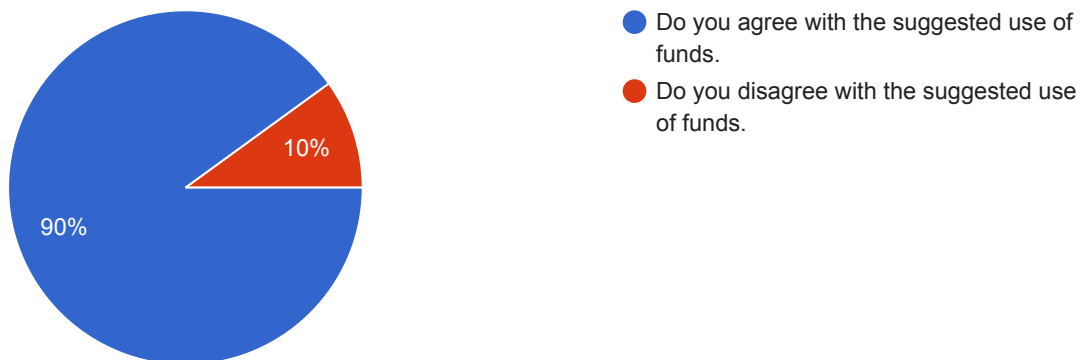

It would benefit students more if we had a teacher's aide in every grade level and three teachers in every grade level for smaller class sizes. Instructional coaches could be great teachers we already have and they can be paid a stipend.

I am a teacher at AB Duncan and I feel like we are in dire need of 3 teachers per grade level even if the numbers are low. Changing these amount of teachers out wrecks the schedule and those teachers can used for extra tutoring or intervention. I feel it is not beneficial to go down to 2 teachers and have huge classes, this defeats the purpose. I also disagree with spending that amount of money on instructional coaches at Duncan. We have teachers on our staff that can mentor and instruct, they could get a stipend and time during the day or after school to do this. OR HIRE! INSTRUCTIONAL COACH FOR THE DISTRICT AND THEN HIRE ENOUGH TEACHERS FOR DUNCAN. We NEED AN AID FOR EACH GRADE LEVEL.

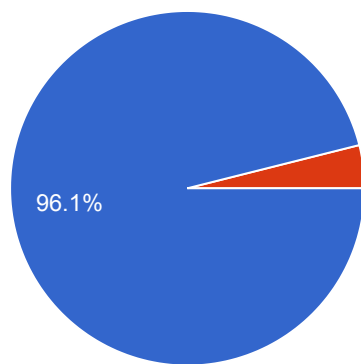
Retention stipend

Duncan needs 3 teachers per grade level and a TA per grade level before we get 2 instructional coaches for \$60,000 a year. If we need "instructional coaches" then get a teacher who is an expert in their subject and give them a stipend for being an instructional coach. If we want to get good teachers to come to Floydada and stay, paying teachers more would be a great incinitive. Dividing \$240,000 between staff could make a pretty big difference in the pay of teachers.

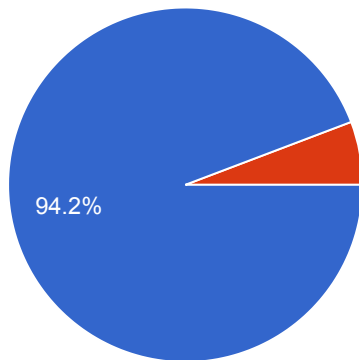

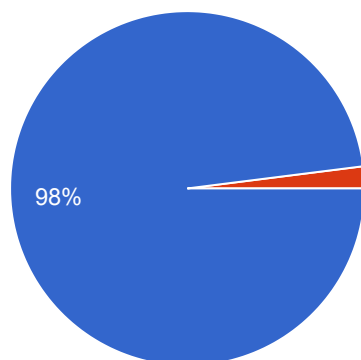

Instrument procurement and replacement for the music programs would be beneficial. We currently have students sharing instruments, and many of the inventory were used instruments purchased during Odom and Ogden's time as directors, so they are now REALLY old. This is the single biggest barrier to student success in the music programs. Anticipated replacement costs for 5-12 grades, after playing on and assessing instrument conditions, would be approximately \$99,725 on the high estimation.

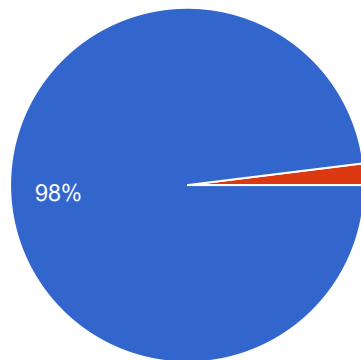
Also, we need a set of Nuvo instruments for the 4th grade to prepare them for beginning band success. These are resilient plastic/synthetic instruments that cost only about \$125 each, and they last an extremely long time. One set for a classroom would cost approximately \$6,250.

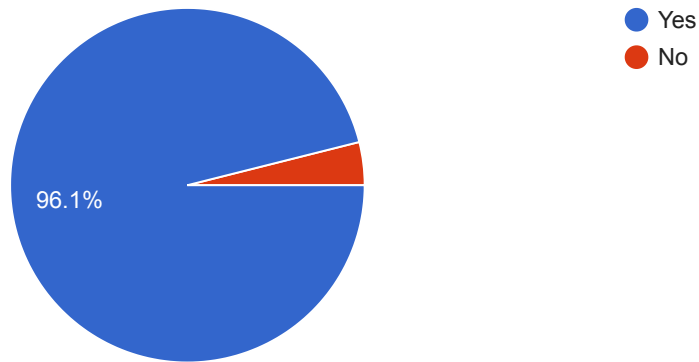
