



Preparing to take the TSI with WCJC

Step One: Complete your application to WCJC on Apply Texas



To take the TSI with WCJC, you must have a WCJC ID number. To create that, apply on ApplyTexas.org. Make sure to fill out the application completely (there are two sections) and then submit to WCJC. **Make sure to use your legal name with no nicknames and that there are no typos or misspellings in either your name or birth date.** You can find a link to ApplyTexas on the WCJC website under Admissions or go to www.applytexas.org. It takes at least three business days to create a WCJC account with ID number. You will receive an e-mail from ApplyTexas stating that you have created an ApplyTexas account and it will include your ApplyTexas account number. *This is not your WCJC confirmation or WCJC ID number.* You will receive an admissions e-mail from a @wcjc.edu

address with confirmation of the creation of your student record with your WCJC ID number (format @#####) (check your e-mail junk folder to make sure your admissions e-mail has not gone there). You can confirm that ApplyTexas sent your application to WCJC by checking on the "My Applications" tab on your ApplyTexas "My Account Dashboard".

Step Two: Watch the Pre Assessment activity and print the certificate

State law requires that all TSI test takers watch a Pre-Assessment activity prior to taking the exam. Before your appointment, please make sure that you have watched the 7 minute Pre Assessment video located on the WCJC website. You can reach the link by going to Admissions and then Testing and then opening the second drop down window (see +) on the main Testing page. At the bottom of that window, there is a big blue link to the "Mandatory Pre-TSIA video". Watch that video. You do not need to print the certificate. You will be asked to sign a form stating you watched the video when you arrive to take your test.



Step Three: Make an appointment with your school

If you have not already been in contact with your counselor (or school organizer), contact them regarding scheduling a time to take the TSI when WCJC will be there.

Step Four: Test day

On test day, you will need to bring a photo ID unless your counselor tells you otherwise.

NO calculators are allowed. There is a calculator that is part of the testing program that will show up on the top menu bar of your test on the problems that a calculator is allowed.

Scratch paper will be provided for you.

You will not be allowed any personal belongings during the exam.
