Academic Common Market – The Academic Common Market (ACM) is a cooperative tuition-reduction agreement among 16 Southern Regional Education Board (SREB) states. The program enables Kentucky students who are interested in an academic program not offered at a public/state-funded university in Kentucky to pay in-state tuition at participating public/state-funded colleges and universities. Athletes:

Planning to attend an NCAA college/university and play a sport? You must register with the NCAA Clearinghouse. Register online – www.eligibilitycenter.org. You **must** have your ACT scores sent to the Clearinghouse, use #9999. You will need to send your transcript to the NCAA Clearinghouse through Parchment. Please select “NCAA Clearinghouse” as the recipient. Be sure you have your ACT scores sent to the Clearinghouse.

Planning to attend an NAIA college/university and play a sport? You must register with the NAIA Eligibility Center – www.playnaia.org. You **must** have your ACT scores sent to the NAIA, use #9876. You will need to send your transcript to the NAIA Clearinghouse through Parchment. Please select “NAIA Clearinghouse” as the recipient.

Cancer Survivors – Scholarships are available for students who are childhood cancer patients/survivors as well as for students who have family members who are cancer patients/survivors. Please see your counselor for a complete list.

Once you register for your account, you can choose to have your transcript sent to your email as well as have it sent to colleges/universities, military recruiters, or even an employer. **Please make sure you use an email address that you check often.** The default email is your school email, which you will not be able to access once you graduate. Therefore, you will need to change your email to your personal email address under “Settings.”

11/20/18- KENTUCKY STUDENT-ATHLETES INVITED TO APPLY FOR 2019 KENTUCKY AG ATHLETES OF THE YEAR

Kentucky senior student-athletes with ties to agriculture may apply for one of six scholarships and the honor of being recognized as a 2019 Kentucky Ag Athlete of the Year.

The program is a partnership of the Kentucky High School Athletic Association (KHSAA) and the Kentucky Department of Agriculture (KDA).

"Students who participate in athletics and work in agriculture must juggle work, sports, and studies to achieve their goals," Agriculture Commissioner Ryan Quarles said. "This program is a way we can recognize their hard work and sacrifice while helping them continue their education."

"Our office is always looking for more ways to honor and recognize the hard work of student-athletes, and we are certainly appreciative of the Department of Agriculture for its sponsorship of this program," said KHSAA Commissioner Julian Tackett. "We realize agriculture students have a lot of responsibilities to balance, and we are thrilled to be able to highlight them for their accomplishments."

To qualify, student-athletes must be involved in agriculture and must plan to attend a college or university following graduation.

Two student-athletes – one male and one female – will be named Outstanding Kentucky Ag Athletes of the Year and will be awarded \$2,000 scholarships. Four student-athletes – two male and two female – will be awarded \$1,000 scholarships as Kentucky Ag Athletes of the Year. Winners will be announced at the 2019 Whitaker Bank/KHSAA Boys' Sweet Sixteen® basketball tournament in March at Rupp Arena in Lexington.

The scholarships are payable to an institution of higher learning. Funding for the scholarships comes from the KDA's "Ag Tag" program, which is funded by voluntary donations from Kentucky motorists when they buy or renew their farm vehicle license plates. No state taxpayer dollars will be used to fund the scholarship awards.

Beginning in 2019, Lockheed Martin will award 200 scholarships of \$10,000 per student - renewable each year. The program will continue to add up to 200 new recipients each year for an investment of \$50 million over five years. The initial focus will be on four-year U.S. college or university attendees, but the program has the capability to expand globally as well as to two-year community college attendees. Mentoring opportunities will be a key component of the program, and recipients will also be eligible for a Lockheed Martin internship following their freshman year in college.

This scholarship is designed to aid intelligent and creative students who are interested in a career in STEM who would otherwise have difficulty fulfilling that dream. This is a clear effort to diversify the pool of future engineers to better position the company to have more inventive solutions and create a culture that better represents what the rest of the country looks like. Diversity is a word that opens doors to new perspectives and shifts "singular" ideologies. This scholarship program is an awesome opportunity for Lockheed Martin to demonstrate its commitment to building a better tomorrow for all races, genders, orientations, economic backgrounds and military statuses by creating a workforce that represents all of them.
