Building Project Update

Ed Anker and Doug Dickinson from CSArch provided a building project planning update. They presented four different options with a varied price range. The board and audience members asked questions. The architects asked that the board make a decision on what features they want and the price range and tax levy impact they were comfortable with bringing to the district residents to vote on. All board members present agreed to go forward with a \$12,000,000 Capital Project voter referendum which includes a 16,000 square foot gymnasium addition with an elevated running track. The board requested additional information and details on a turf field which would be a separate proposition.
