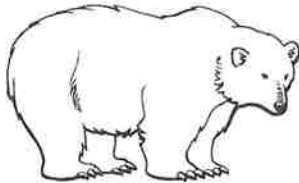

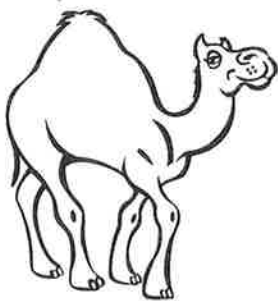

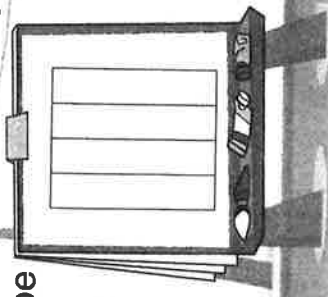

How can you describe the shares of the curtain that are red?

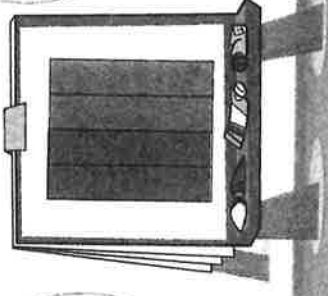
I can draw a picture of the curtain with 4 equal shares.
