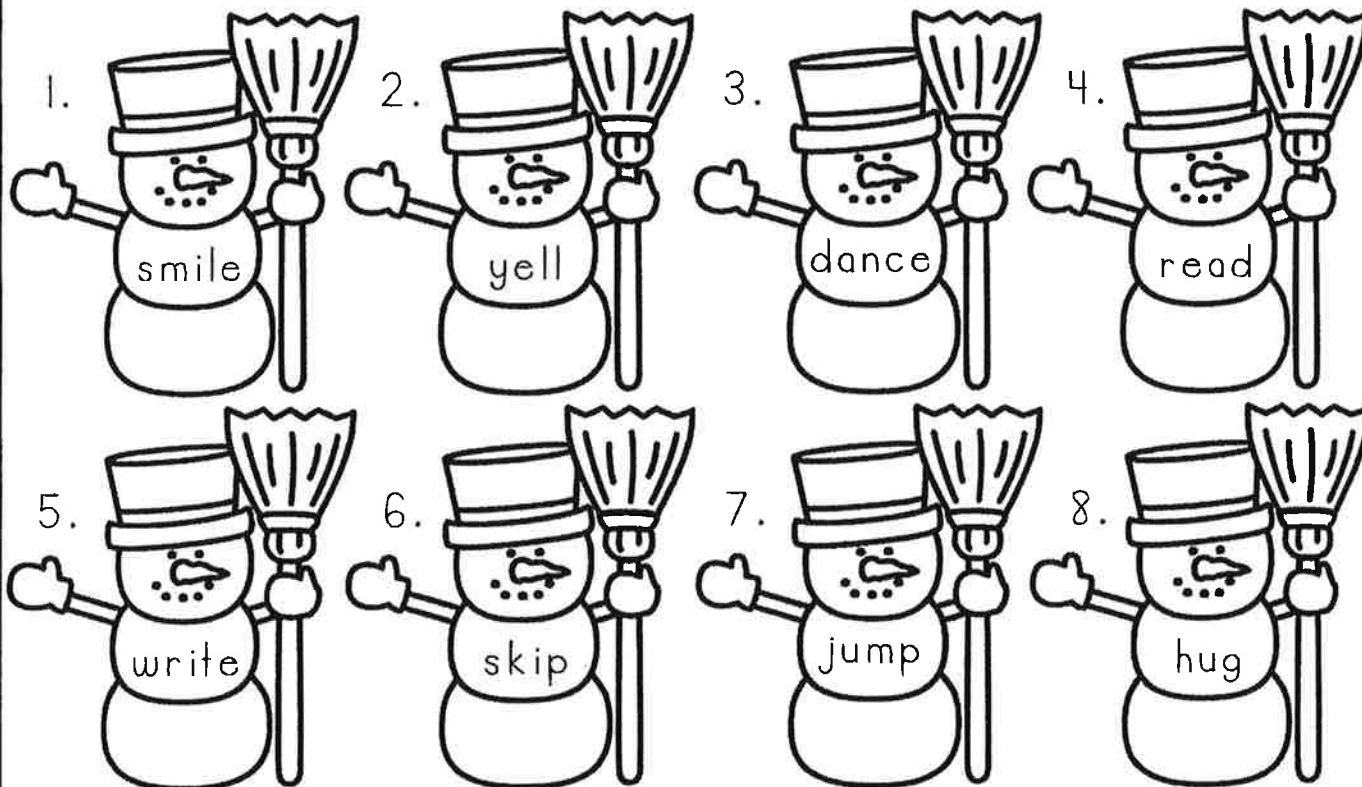
snowman adverbs and verbs

Directions: Read the verb in each snowman. Fill in the blank snowball with the adverb from below that describes each noun.

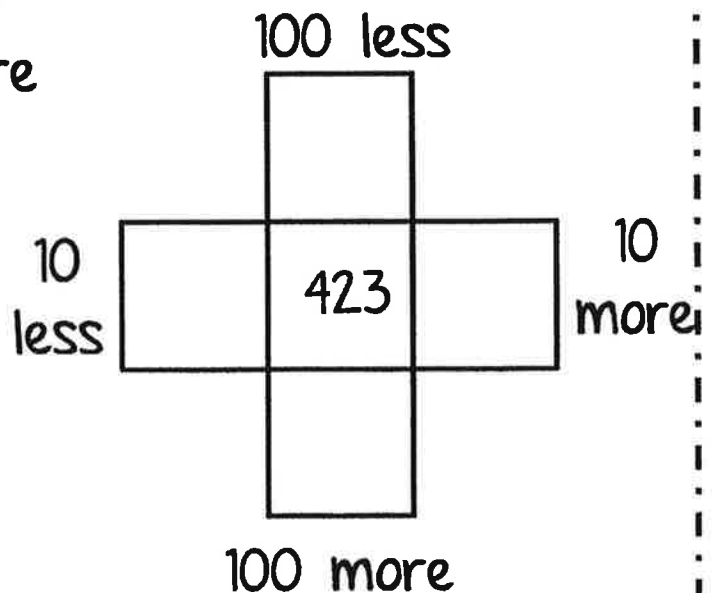
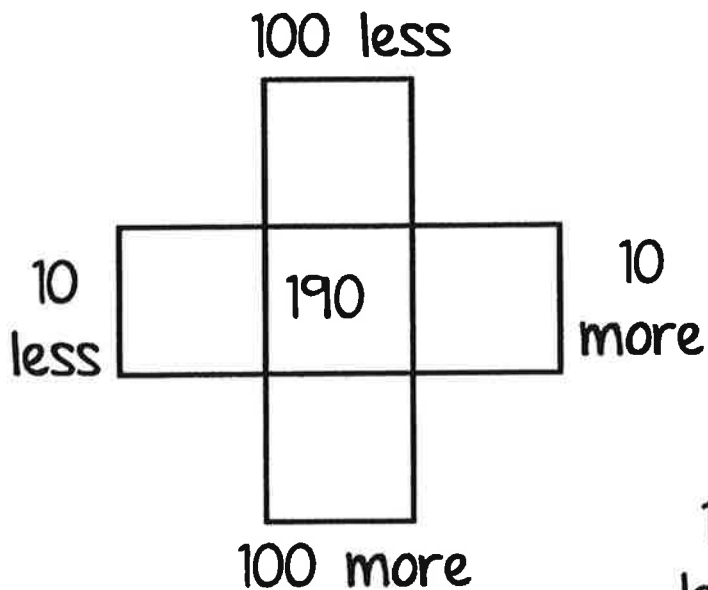
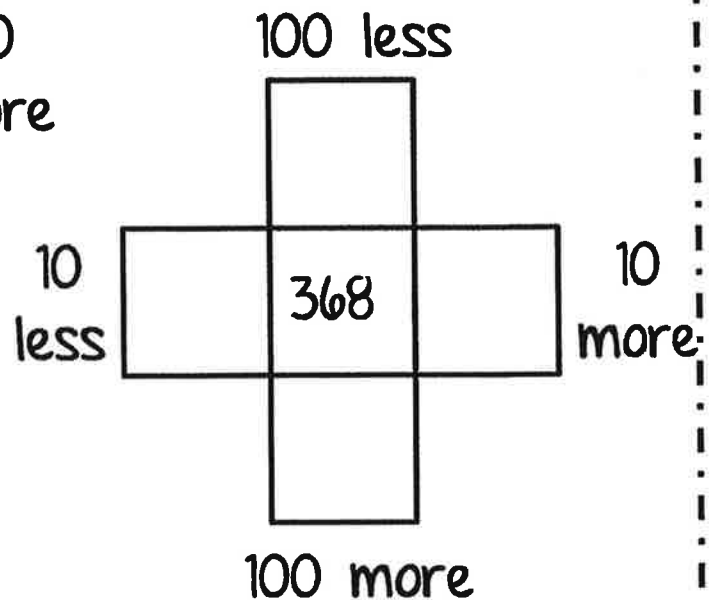
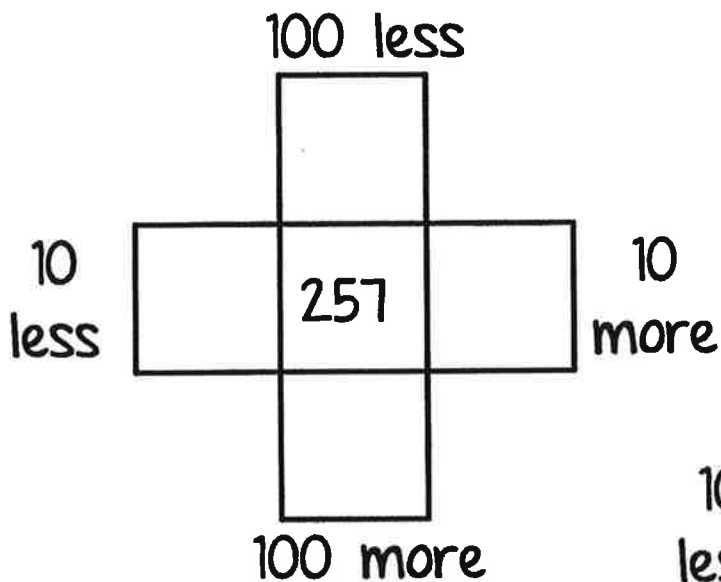
