Academic After School Assistance 2023-2024

Dear parents and students

After school tutoring/remediation support for students who are failing a class or at-risk of failing a class or who need extra help with assignments, upcoming tests, etc. will begin September 5, 2023. This remediation session is available Monday-Thursday from 3:15-4:15. Teachers who have students who need to come will sign these students up. Therefore, if your child is failing a class and needs tutoring, please contact your child's teacher and discuss this option. Parents and students are responsible for transportation.

Attendance: ALSO, students who have exceeded their absences for a class or who are CLOSE to exceeding absences for a class will be assigned AFTER SCHOOL from administration to recover the attendance time. Students who exceed absences for the semester and do not come for attendance recovery will NOT get credit for the class at the end of the semester.

General Information

Who: Students who are failing or are at risk of failing an academic class or who need attendance credit recovery time.

What: Tutoring and retest opportunities for students who need extra help

When: Monday-Thursday from 3:15-4:15

Where: SCHS

How: One teacher from English, Math, Science, Social Studies will be available to help students complete missing assignments, prepare to retake failed/missed assessments, and receive tutoring in areas of need. Each student's teacher will provide the After School Assistance teacher with the work the student needs to complete successfully in order to improve their mastery of the standards and performance in class. A student must be assigned by their teacher ahead of time to attend After School Assistance. Teachers will contact parents when they assign a student After School Assistance to let parents know and be sure of attendance.

Supplies: Students must bring pens, pencils, paper, notes, books, or any materials they need to work on the assignments left by their teacher.
