2 boxes of thin dry erase markers

1 pair of kid scissors (Blunt tip)

1 box of baby wipes

2 or more large Elmer's glue sticks
1 highlighter
2 low odor dry erase markers (any colors)

1 standard size plastic pencil box
2 boxes of 12 or 24 Crayola colored pencils
1 pair of scissors
1 heavy-duty pocket folder with horizontal pockets
1 box of tissues
