1. COVID-19 Purchases
 - a. Hand sanitizer- voted and approved via messenger May 30th to approve the purchase of individual sanitizers for each softball player.
2. Sink update - Aaron purchased a sink and hose to be used as a hand washing station for the softball team. He placed it in the concession stand, hooked into the water heater. Will need to come up with a way to create a drain option outside the building instead of the 5 gallon bucket currently being used. This can now be used during football games.

6. Concession Stand Update-Stacey reported there are now water bottles in the football concession stand to use in an emergency during softball. She asked about doing a call ahead/pickup order for concession stand items but it was decided that wouldn't follow Covid-19 guidelines. Jolene and Stacey have discussed sharing the concession stand manager responsibilities. They will make a decision how it will work best for them and split the pay 50/50.

Activities Director Report: Participation data is almost complete. We do know that future forecasts show very low numbers for girls in upcoming classes. We need to get them engaged and interested in sports at a young age to encourage a high % to participate during jh and high school.
