General Summer School Information

Focus

The District 117 2020 summer school will offer five types of classes:

- **Credit recovery** for course failures.
- **Credit bearing** courses for a grade and credit.
- **Enrichment** courses.
- **Bridge** programs in preparation for the fall.
- **Freshman Academy** for selected students.

Location

Summer School courses will be held at both Antioch and Lakes High Schools. Students who enroll in the Freshmen Academy and Credit Recovery programs will attend their assigned school. All enrichment courses will be scheduled at each respective high school if enrollment allows and where the majority of the enrollment occurs.

Registration

To register for summer school classes, submit the course selection and registration forms along with payment to the student's counselor. Registration deadlines vary – see individual course offerings for details.

Tuition and Fees

Credit bearing and credit recovery courses are \$225 (per 0.5 credit), except where noted. Full payment of tuition/fees is required at registration.

All outstanding school fees must be paid in full prior to enrolling in summer school courses.

Class Limits/Cancellations

Class registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Early enrollment is important since time slots and openings are limited. Classes without sufficient enrollment may be cancelled. Community High School District 117 students have first priority for enrollment purposes.

Refunds

No refunds will be made **after Tuesday, June 2, 2020**. Refunds will be applied toward future registration fees within District 117. Refunds will be issued only if the class is cancelled due to extenuating circumstances as determined by the principal.

Attendance/Tardy Policy

Summer school is a voluntary regular education program, but students are required to attend all classes. **Daily attendance is critical to a student's ability to be successful in summer school.** If a student is ill, the parent/guardian should contact the school secretary at the respective buildings before 7:30 A.M. the day of the absence. At Lakes High School the number is 847-838-7623. At Antioch High School the number is 847-838-7189. Repeated tardiness will be cause for dismissal from class without credit or refund.

NOTE: Since Summer School hours are limited, daily attendance is extremely important. For Summer Freshman Academy a minimum of fourteen attendance days are required to receive credit. As a rule, students will be dropped from **ANY** summer school classes after two absences due to the compacted time and necessary instructional hours. Please plan vacations and camps accordingly. Exceptions should be appealed to each building summer school principal.

Transportation

Bus transportation IS provided for ALL SUMMER FRESHMAN ACADEMY students. Any student displaying financial hardship may also qualify as well for free transportation with counselor or administrative approval. Students can be dropped off and picked up in the designated areas. Students who are licensed drivers may drive to summer school. Cars driven to campus should not be moved or entered until the students leave the campus at the end of their school day. **Students must park in the student parking lots east of the respective buildings. Violators will be ticketed or towed at the expense of the owner.** All vehicles parked on school grounds may be subject to search if the school administration suspects a violation of school rules. Students must register their vehicles with the main office on the first day of school.

Closed Campus

Both Antioch and Lakes High Schools are closed campus schools. Students must remain in the building until their last classes are completed. Students who leave campus during a session or during break will be considered unexcused and could be dropped from the course with a loss of fees and credit.

Student Discipline

Rules and regulations of the regular school year are in effect according to District 117 policies. Students removed from class for disruptive or inappropriate behavior may be dropped from the school program with a loss of fees and credit.

Bridge/Enrichment Courses:

SAT/ACT Prep: Cost \$150

June 1 - June 12 **7:45am- 9:45am** or **10:00am-12:00pm**

Registration Deadline: May 1

Elective 9-12; no credit, no grade

This non-credit course will allow students to hone their SAT/ACT test preparedness. During the SAT/ACT Prep program, teachers will help students improve their knowledge base and test taking skills. Students will attend ten sessions that will acquaint them with the expectations of the test, enable them to analyze their own results and sharpen their understanding of key skills covered on the test.

MATH

AP Calculus Bridge Class: Cost \$225

June 1 - June 19 **7:45am-12:00pm**

Registration Deadline: May 1

Elective, no credit, no grade

This non-credit, three-week course for incoming juniors and seniors is by teacher recommendation only. It is designed to bridge the curriculum between Integrated Math 3 Honors and AP Calculus AB or BC and requires a high level of mastery of all previous math classes. Students will be expected to make connections, think abstractly, and provide justifications while working numerically, geometrically, symbolically, and verbally. *A TI-84 graphing calculator is required.*

Integrated Math 2 Honors Bridge Class (Invite Only)

June 1 - June 19 **7:45am-12:00pm**

Registration Deadline: May 1

Elective, no credit, no grade, no charge

This non-credit, three-week course is for recommended freshmen who meet the following criteria: NWEA math scores of 245+ and D117 department chair recommendation. This course is required for students who have completed a middle school Algebra 1 course and want to enroll in Integrated Math 2 Honors - the second-year course in D117's Integrated Math Curriculum. Units in basic geometry, geometric reasoning, one-variable statistics, and two-variable statistics will cover the standards aligned to D117's Integrated Math 1 Honors course that are not taught in traditional Algebra 1 courses. *A TI-84 graphing calculator is required.*

SOCIAL STUDIES

AP History Bridge Class: Cost \$150

June 8 - June 19 **7:45am- 9:45am** or **10:00am-12:00pm**

Registration Deadline: May 1

Elective, no credit, no grade

This non-credit course is for recommended students who meet the following criteria: students interested in enrolling in either AP European History or AP United States History in the fall. The curriculum will focus on skills that will support success in college level history courses. Skills such as effective reading, and note taking, thesis development, vocabulary development, document analysis, FRQ/DBQ, organization, and use of evidence to support claims will be emphasized.

AP Human Geography Bridge Class (Invite Only)

June 8 – June 12 **7:45am- 9:45am** or **10:00am-12:00pm** **@ Antioch Community High School**
June 22 - June 26 **7:45am- 9:45am** or **10:00am-12:00pm** **@ Lakes Community High School**
Elective, no credit, no grade, no charge

Registration Deadline: May 1

This non-credit course is recommended for students interested in enrolling in AP Human Geography in the fall. The curriculum will focus on skills including: writing Free Response Questions, analyzing data on maps, charts, and graphs in a college level history course, effective reading and study skills, and more. This course will support AP Human Geography students in being successful critical thinkers in a college level history course.

SCIENCE

AP Chemistry Bridge Class: Cost \$75

June 1 - June 5 **7:45am- 9:45am** or **10:00am-12:00pm** **Registration Deadline: May 1**
Elective, no credit, no grade

This non- credit, one-week course is recommended for students enrolling in AP Chemistry in the fall. The course will focus on the major content objectives needed in order to begin the year in AP Chemistry.

AP Biology Bridge Class: Cost \$75

June 1 - June 5 **7:45am- 9:45am** or **10:00am-12:00pm** **Registration Deadline: May 1**
Elective, no credit, no grade

This non-credit, one-week course is recommended for students enrolling in AP Biology in the fall. The course will focus on the major Biology content objectives necessary to begin the year in AP Biology.

Sustainable Living: Cost \$225

June 1 - June 19 **7:45am-12:00pm** **Registration Deadline: May 1**
Elective 09-12, no credit, no grade **@ Lakes Community High School**

Become a more thoughtful consumer and reduce your ecological footprint with this course that teaches you how to integrate sustainable practices into your everyday life. By learning specific knowledge and techniques on how to work more efficiently with the energy, water, and food you consume, you can live a more balanced and sustainable lifestyle that also positively impacts the world around you. This class includes field trips to local businesses and farms as well as time establishing and maintaining our district garden.

CREDIT BEARING COURSES:

Life Resource Management (LRM): Cost \$225

June 1 - June 19 7:45am-12:00pm

Elective 11-12, 1 semester, 0.5 credit

10th Grade with Department Chair Recommendation

***Registration Deadline: May 1
@ Lakes Community High School***

LRM teaches students the skills necessary to live on their own. The majority of the topics covered will be project-based experiences. Topics include consumer rights and responsibilities, money management (including checking and credit), and employment preparation. This course fulfills the Consumer Education graduation requirement.

Personal Finance: Cost \$225

June 1 - June 19 7:45am-12:00pm

Elective 11-12, 1 semester, 0.5 credit

10th Grade with Department Chair Recommendation

Personal Finance helps prepare students for life on their own. Students will gain the knowledge necessary to make wise financial decisions that will benefit their personal and professional lives. The major areas of study will focus on banking, budgeting, obtaining and using credit, renting an apartment, comparison shopping, insurance, financial management, and sources of consumer information. Projects and hands on activities are a vital part of this course, including the Virtual Business—Personal Finance simulation. This course meets the Consumer Education requirement for graduation.

American Government: Cost \$225

June 1 - June 19 7:45am-12:00pm

Required 12 only, 1 semester, 0.5 credit

Registration Deadline: May 1

American Government is designed to provide students with the necessary knowledge and skills to participate effectively in a democratic society. Students will gain a strong understanding of how federal and state governments operate, how the government's actions affect individuals and the role of citizens in the democratic system. Class activities include research and exploration, written projects, discussion of current and controversial topics, and simulations. This class will prepare students for the required examinations on the Illinois and United States Constitutions and meets the state civics graduation requirement.

Art 2D (Two dimensional): Cost \$225

June 1 - June 19 7:45am-12:00pm

Elective 9-12, 1 semester, 0.5 credit

Registration Deadline: May 1

This credit class is a general introduction to drawing, painting, collage, elements of art, principles of design, and art history. Students will be introduced to various media and techniques in producing two-dimensional works of art.

Art 3D (Three dimensional): Cost \$225

June 1 - June 19 7:45am-12:00pm

Elective 9-12, 1 semester, 0.5 credit

Registration Deadline: May 1

This credit class is a general introduction to sculpture, ceramics, elements of art and principles of design, and art history. Students will work with various materials and techniques in producing three-dimensional works of art.

Driver Education: Cost \$300

June 1 – June 25 (no Fri) 7am- 11am or 9am-1pm or 11am-3pm @ Antioch Community High School
Driver Education credit, 1 semester, 0.5 credit

Registration Deadline: May 1

Students must be 15 by June 1, 2020 to enroll and have adult/guardian permission.

This driver education course is an accelerated two-phase program that consists of 16 days of classroom instruction and 6 hours of behind the wheel (BTW) instruction. Students will attend a 2-hour block of classroom instruction to meet the 30-hour classroom requirement from the State of Illinois. Students will then be in the car for a 2-hour block with a driving instructor; 1 hour of driving training and 1 hour of observation to meet the 6-hour BTW training requirement from the State of Illinois. Students will receive driving training every other day with an instructor. In addition, students must receive a minimum of 2 hours of home practice each week during the course. Driving outside this course is crucial to the completion and success in this program. Attendance is critical for meeting the curriculum and Illinois State law requirements. Students will only be allowed one medical or extenuating absence and proper documentation will need to be submitted. After 1 absence a student will be dropped from the course; if documentation is not provided and any more absences, students will be dropped from the course even for illness. Classes will be held Monday thru Thursday each week (pending extension of the 2019-20 school year).

Students must have a permit on the first day of the course, students are eligible to receive a permit 30 days prior to the start date. Students may attend permit testing at the high school or they MUST visit the DMV. Students should begin reviewing the Rules of the Road when they register for the course.

Note: There is a separate \$20 permit fee required by the Secretary of State in Illinois. Further information about permit testing will be shared later in the spring.

60 seats will be filled on a first come first serve basis for the 3 time slots 7-11, 9-1, 11-3.
Once a time slot is filled, students will be offered their 2nd or 3rd choice.

Prerequisite: Successful completion of eight courses within the past two semesters.

This course is designed to foster reading, writing, math, and organizational skills for selected incoming freshmen as well as build social-emotional skills including growth mindset, resilience, self-efficacy and grit.

Semester 1 session 7:45am-9:45am and Semester 2 session 10:00am-12:00pm

For students who have failed a Semester 1 or 2 course

Cost: \$225

Registration Deadline: May 29

Students can recover up to 1.0 credit by registering for up to two courses and two time periods. Satisfactory completion of a combination of online assignments and independent written work will fulfill course requirements with a grade of "P" for Pass. No grade point value will be assigned.
