




Coach Doyscher said, "It's just a group of kids who were resilient of all the disappointments, but hung in there and continued to do their job. It paid off in the end."












Coach Willhite said, "We are hoping to finish in the top half of the Conference. We finished in the top three for four years in a row, we would like to do that again this year."





The practices required the cast to be very focused, but also had room to goof off and do "silly" runs of the show where they'd use different voices or change the words.


Everyone brought their best to the stage and they made a great ensemble.














