Here's an update on what's happening with the bond program for Schoolcraft Community Schools.

Overall Project Status

- TMP, the architect, and Triangle, the construction manager, are doing a lot of work behind the scenes right now, so we don't have a lot of new information to report.

7/8 Grade Addition to High School

- The steering team will be reviewing the budget and interior design concepts for this project during the month of June.
- Design development should be complete in July.
- The user group will meet in August for the final design presentation and budget update.
- Construction documents should be complete in September.

New Elementary K-6 Building

- The user group will meet for a kickoff meeting and vision planning this week.
- We will be doing concept exploration and master planning in July.
- Concept selection and refinement will take place in August.
- Schematic design should be complete in September.

- Design development should be complete in January 2021.
- Construction documents should be complete in April 2021.

7/8 Gym

- We continue to explore the best location for the gym and are considering both the high school and the new K-6 building as possible locations.

Athletic Improvements

- Our priority is the educational spaces, so this project is on hold for now.
