



CDL'S TEEN APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM (TAP) IS RECRUITING TEENS IN SEARCH OF LEADERSHIP OPPORTUNITIES THIS SUMMER.

Participant applications are accepted until June 24th, 2020.

Due to social distancing regulations we will serve 2 cohorts of teens 13 per cohort and will be designing (using SolidWorks) a completely off the grid tiny home for our new CDL Homeless Veteran OFF GRID Home Building Program as well as remodeling approx. 4-6 homes on the South Side of Providence. Teens will rotate weekly to allow each to be part of both initiatives in our community. Students will receive a modest stipend, AED/First Aide/CPR certification as well as an Osha certification. All students earning a grade of a B or better will receive 3 college Credits in our Manufacturing Engineering program through RWU.
