Woodbridge Township Parents, Guardians, and Friends:

Effective immediately, all Woodbridge Township schools will be closed next week, from Monday, March 16, 2020 through Friday, March 20, 2020. During this time, all school activities will be suspended, including any extracurricular activities, sports, practices, and trips. At the end of next week, we will re-evaluate and send updates. There still remains a possibility of extending the closure beyond next week.

Even though two weeks ago a district-wide public school closure seemed an extremely remote possibility, we have been preparing for a crisis such as this one. We created a Pandemic Crisis Management Plan to guide our practices for a health-related school closure. We have plans in place to continue to educate our children and to provide necessary support services. We feel our distance learning procedures, contained in the Pandemic Crisis Management Plan, will provide the best possible daily instruction for our students.

You will be receiving more emails with details for instruction and attendance. All teachers, administrators, and support staff will still be on duty every day to support distance learning.

At this point, the most important thing to remember is your family's health and safety. Please review all guidelines provided by our health officials.

We will be communicating any updates as soon as we receive them. We also ask that everyone remember that although this is an unprecedented, global crisis, it is only temporary. Before long, we will be back at school and resuming all activities.
