



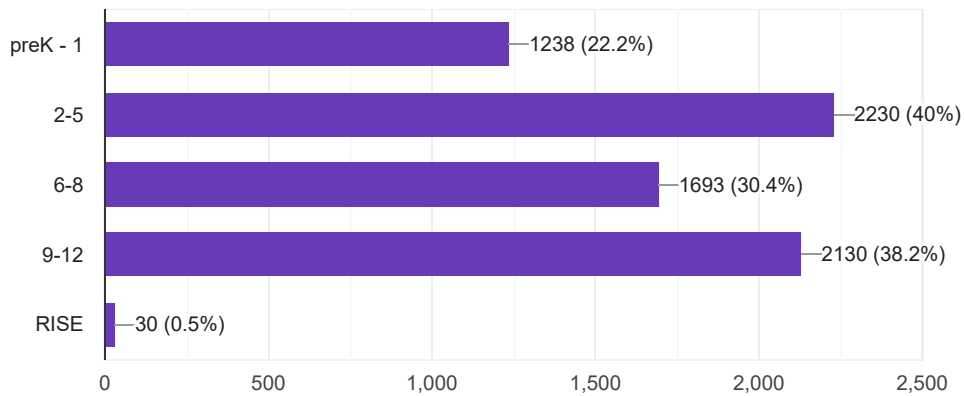

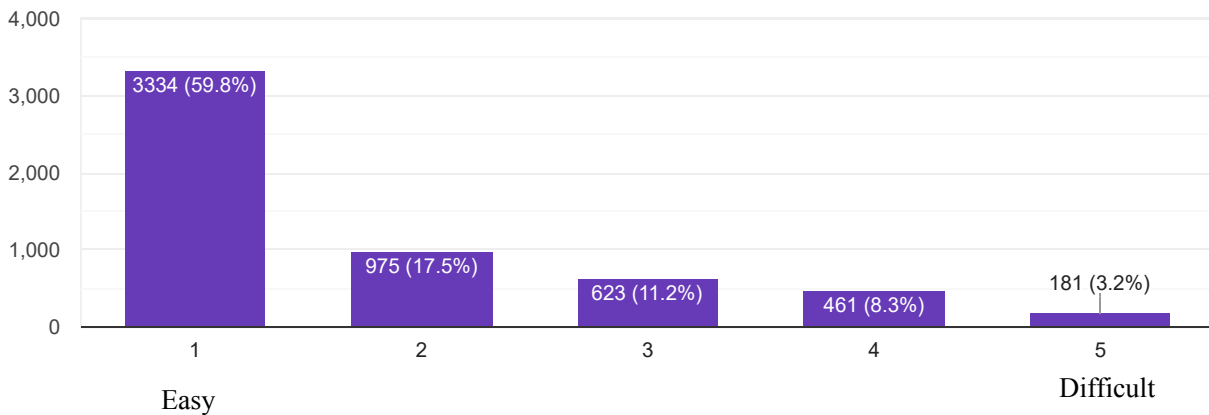
### What grade level are your students are in?

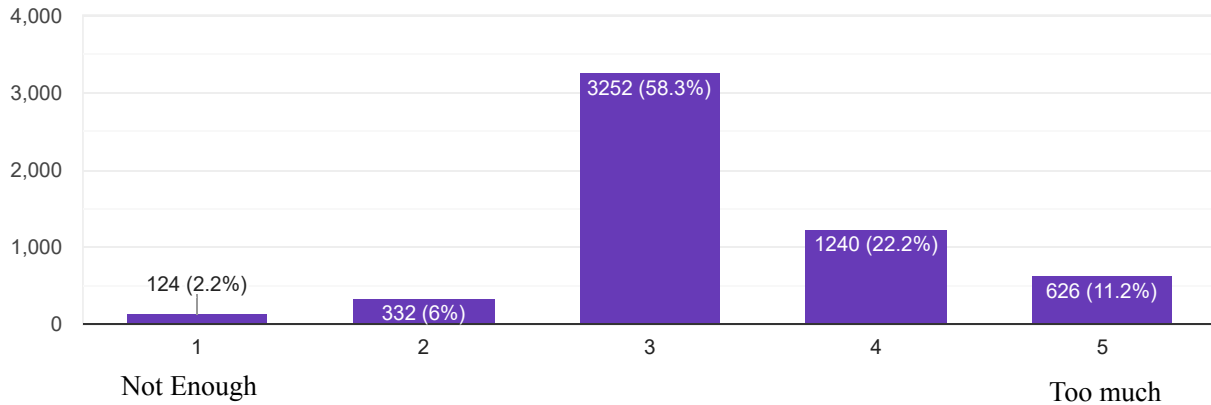
### How easy is it to access the daily instruction?

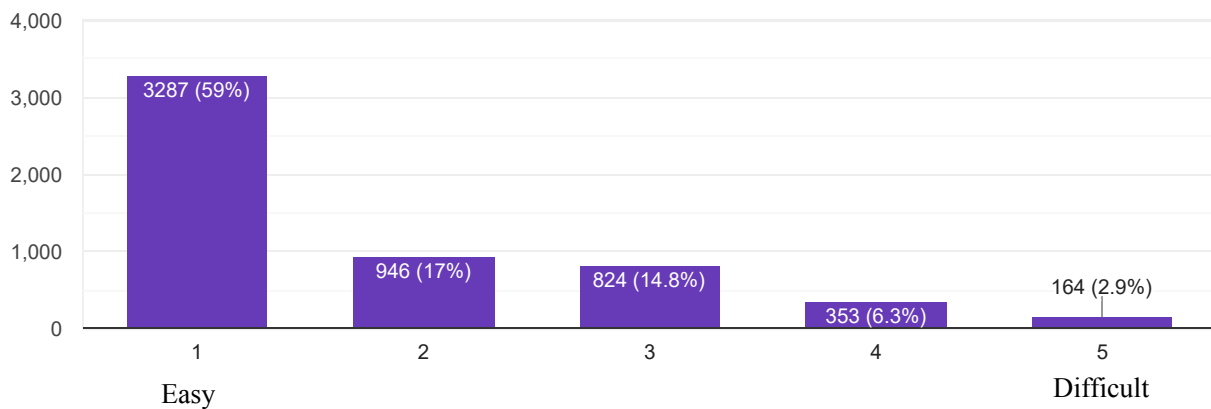
### What is your opinion of the amount of work your children are doing every day?

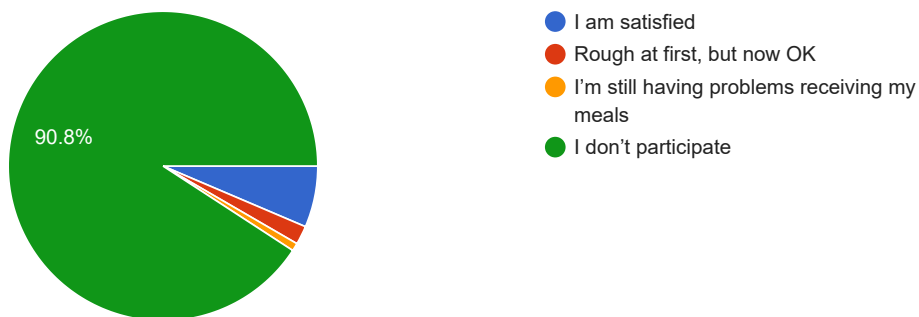
### How have you found the communication process with your teacher?
