Parents and Guardians of Woodbridge Township:

We hope everyone is safe and healthy. We have been continuing to review our procedures for distance learning. As a result, the Board of Education and the administration, along with input from teachers and parents, will be making the following changes:

1. We will be shortening spring break by three days. We will be off on Monday, April 13 and Tuesday, April 14. We will be holding classes the rest of the week. We will make a decision on the three unused snow days and the last day of school in the near future. There are many reasons for this decision, but the most considerable factors are the survey results, which showed 76% of the 5,500 responses were in favor of working through spring break.
2. Marking Period 3 ends this Friday, April 3. Report cards will be posted on April 10. There will be no changes to grading for Marking Period 3. For Marking Period 4, all elementary schools will grade on a pass/fail basis. This means students will receive either a "P" for pass or "F" for failure. No other letter grades will be given. The reason behind this decision is to help ease any anxiety or stress for teachers or students. We also do not want to have students' academic records or emotional health harmed by situations beyond their control.

We hope this helps all Woodbridge families to get through the coronavirus pandemic. We will post the survey results on the website. Thank you to all who participated.
