

Program Description

In Woodbridge Township School District we focus our Title I funds at the elementary school level. Elementary schools qualify for Title 1 funds based on percentage of low income families. The following schools are Title I schools: School 4 & 5, School 9, School 11, School 19, School 23, School 25, School 27 and School 28.

All of the Title I schools implement a targeted assistance program that services only identified low performing students. For schools operating a targeted assistance Title I program, services may benefit only those students who meet the established criteria defined by the school. Woodbridge Township School District utilizes multiple measures, which include but are not limited to, end-of-year assessment scores, past academic performance, and teacher recommendation. Students will continue to be monitored for academic improvement and may exit the program on the basis of multiple measures that include, but are not limited to, a proficient score on an end-of-year assessment, academic performance and/or teacher recommendation.

The goal of our Title I program is to ensure that all identified children obtain a high-quality education and achieve, at a minimum, proficiency on the challenging Common Core State Standards as measured by state assessments.
