REFUND POLICY

Cancellations made prior to the second class may receive a full refund, less an \$8.00 service fee (on classes 3 days or less the refund will be prorated). No refunds will be given after the scheduled date of the second class. If a class is not filled or is cancelled, a full refund will be given. Refunds can take 2 weeks to process. A fee of \$35 will be assessed for returned checks.

Swim Class Descriptions

Aqua Babies 1: Ages 6 months-2 years old This age group is about bonding with the parent as they provide support & guidance at all times. Children are still developing strength and coordination while exploring the water environment. We play games and sing songs as parents learn how to hold their child and move them through the water. A parent must be in the water with the child for the Aqua Babies classes

Aqua Babies 2: Ages 2-4 years old This age group is ready to explore swimming more independently with the parent's guidance. Children will develop core strength, begin learning coordination of strokes and kicks while using noodles & equipment for support to help improve swimming skills. Water safety is also addressed. **A parent must be in the water with the child for the Aqua Babies classes.**

Level 1: Basic Water Skills 4-5 years Child must be comfortable in the water without a parent. Class includes introduction to the water environment, blowing bubbles/putting face in the water, front/back kicks, front/back floats, arm scoops, water submersion & water safety.

Level 2: Stroke Development 5-7 years Child must have prior swim instruction or basic swim skills. Development of front/back strokes, rhythmic breathing, flipping front to back/back to front, breaststroke pull & underwater exploration.

Level 3: Stroke Improvement 6-10 years Child must have taken Level 2 or instructor approval based on their skills. Continued stroke improvement on front/back, breaststroke basics, intro to butterfly, diving & treading water.

AMERICAN RED CROSS LIFEGUARD CERTIFICATION

Fee: \$210.00 All materials included. Must be 15 years of age or older to certify.

Includes Lifeguard, CPR for the Professional Rescuer (PR) First Aid (FA) and Automated External Defibrillator (AED) Certification. Please note: All students must attend all sessions below in order to complete the certification in Lifeguard, CPR-PR, FA and AED. Lifeguard pre-requirements: Swim: 300 yards continuously demonstrating breath control and rhythmic



breathing; tread water for 2 minutes using legs only; complete a diving test within 1 minute and 40 seconds, starting in the water, swim 20 yards, surface dive to 7-10 feet to retrieve 10 pound object, return to surface and swim 20 yards to starting point, exit the water without using a ladder or steps. This course is a blended learning class requiring in-person instruction and an online portion. The online portion must be completed before the first class.

To recertify, you must also pass the 3 in-water scenarios and CPR/AED scenarios as well as complete and pass the written tests for all certifications you are attempting to re-certify. You must be able to do the following swimming skills as a prerequisite before attempting to re-certify: Swim 300 yards continuously demonstrating breath control and rhythmic breathing; tread water for 2 minutes using legs only; complete a diving test within 1 minute and 40 seconds, starting in the water, swim 20 yards, surface dive to 7-10 feet to retrieve 10 pound object, return to surface and swim 20 yards to starting point, exit the water without using a ladder or steps.
