


Regular Board of Education Meeting
April 8, 2020
Virtual Meeting

1. The regular meeting of the Abingdon-Avon CUSD 276 Board of Education was held on April 8, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. with Brooks presiding. The following members were present: Serven, Mason, Craver, Hess, Terwilliger, and Brooks. Mr. Quinn was absent.
2. Additions/Deletions to the Agenda –

 3. Student Admission Costs – *Dr. Curry and Mr. Weedman discussed the idea that all D276 students will get in free with a student ID.*
 4. District Planning Update – *Dr. Curry noted that there is potential that our projects may go on the shelf for a couple years. We will still be ready if the State has enough money to fund projects. I would think the lack of sales tax, payroll taxes, and the unbelievable high cost of fighting the virus and its wake will take a toll on discretionary spending at the State level.*
 5. ISBE Maintenance Grant Information *Dr. Curry noted that we are still waiting to receive official approval.*
 6. Secure Classroom Latches - *Dr. Curry noted this is a purchase he recommends the district make in May – Approximately \$34,000.*
 7. Early Release Dates for 2020-2021 - *Dr. Curry noted that he is recommending one hour early release every Friday in 20-21.*
 8. Coronavirus Update - *Dr. Curry noted that at the time of the meeting, there was little news to share.*

9. District Office Art Gallery - *Dr. Curry noted that he has sent pictures of student artwork that is on display at the office.*
