Internet service was delayed for two families, however, the school offered some temporary options until other arrangements could be secured. We acquired 25 hotspots for family (23) and staff (2) use.

New Hope’s population consists of two (2) Foster youth, 56% English learners, and 90% low-income. Due to these demographics, programs are implemented on a school-wide basis.

New Hope is a one-to-one district; we had all technology devices in place at the time of school closure.

School meals have been provided for all students’ ages 0-18 from March 17, and they will continue thru June 30, 2020. Bus riders, requesting meals, have meals delivered to their homes. All other take part in a drive thru procedure with “grab ‘n go meals for breakfast and lunch. Meal service is provided for all children on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays. Enough food is provided for five (5) days’.
