

Use of Feature Films/Videos in the School**

Prior to showing a feature film/video in a school, the instructor must seek the written approval of the building principal. At least five days prior to the showing, the instructor shall submit to the principal (in writing) the following information on the particular film:

1. Title and brief description;
2. Purpose for the showing;
3. Match with course objectives;
4. Proposed date of showing;
5. When and how parents will be notified, or if necessary grant consent;
6. Audience rating (G, PG, PG-13, R).

The showing of feature films/videos, unless otherwise provided below, requires prior parent notification from the instructor who will summarize in writing the information in the above points 1, 2, 4 and 6. Additionally, prior parent consent will be required as follows:

1. Grades K-6 - PG rated films/videos;
2. Grades 7-8 - PG-13 rated films/videos;
3. Grades 9-12 - R rated films/videos. Prior written permission of the principal is also required for instructors requesting permission to show R rated films.

Parental notification for the showing of G movies at the high school level will be at the discretion of the building administrator.

Instructors are required to preview all film/videos before showing to students. A parent may have the opportunity to preview a film/video when practicably possible.

Edited or unrated films/videos will be shown at the discretion of the building administrator.
