JNPSD School Community:

After the events of the last few days, listed below is a summary of information that you may find helpful as it relates to the COVID-19 virus. Some of the information is repeated from previous notifications.

1. JNPSD schools will be closed until March 30. All school athletics and other activities are suspended until March 30. All staff and scholar school travel is suspended until further notice. Unless otherwise directed by the Governor, Arkansas Department of Health, and Arkansas Department of Education, classes will resume on March 30.
2. Middle school and high school scholars will access classroom lessons via Google classroom. Elementary school scholars will work on lessons that were sent home last October as well as items sent home last week. 3. Teachers and principals will be available by phone, email, or other communication means (Class Dojo, etc) during normal school hours each day.
4. The JNPSD district office will be open from 8:30 am – Noon on March 16-20 for essential / emergency business only. Administrative staff will be available by phone or email.
5. Please check our social media outlets for information on sack lunches and family food boxes that will be available this week. The sites include the Jacksonville Boys and Girls Club, Mt Pisgah Baptist Church, Care Channel, Willow Bend, and Max Howell Place.
6. Please follow all safeguards as recommended by the Arkansas Department of Health. Please review our previous updates concerning these recommendations and access to information.
