




Dear Incoming 6th Grade Families,

ELA (English Language Arts)	3 dozen(36)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>three dozen "cap" erasers and/or a few block erasers (like Prismacolor "Magic Rub, "PaperMate, "Pink Pearl" or other brand)</li> </ul>
MATH	4 4 dozen(48) 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>four black fine-line "Dry-Erase" (Expo) markers</li> <li>four dozen pencils with erasers, not mechanical</li> <li>one roll clear tape in a dispenser (disposable)</li> </ul>
SCIENCE	1 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>one roll clear tape in a dispenser (disposable)</li> <li>three glue sticks</li> </ul>

"SOS" (Study & Organizational Skills)		Please note: In the past our students have purchased shelves for their lockers. This is an expense that we have eliminated, as we are using online textbooks exclusively. (Most of the shelves and hanging pockets cause the lockers to jam.) The locker alone should be sufficient to store belongings.

"Mission Control" Zippered Binder & Pencil Cases 	1 2 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>one STURDY two-inch (2") zippered binder with 3 rings, any color, shoulder strap is OPTIONAL</li> <li>two zippered pencil cases with rivets, any color (one for binder, one for storage) NO BOX PENCIL CASES, please</li> <li>two plastic folders WITH HOLES, NO SPINES to fit in the "Mission Control" binder, ONE BLACK and one any other color</li> </ul>
