Middle School and AD report was given by Ron Erpenbach. This is the last week on paper copy work being sent home. Thank you to all staff; especially Debbie Dettmann and Renee Messner for all your hard work and organization during this time. June 1 & 2 Kids/Parents can drop off text books/Chromebook etc. There will be tables set up outside labeled by grade. A new grading scale for MS and HS was sent out to parents; Ron and Tom used guidance from MDE regarding the grading scale. Finally; MSHSL had said NO CONTACT with student athletes through July. MDH says May; but MSHSL trumps MDH; so as of now; no contact through July.

High School report was given by Tom Erickson. Student books and Chromebook drop off June 1 & 2 for grades 6-11; Thursday May 21 for Seniors. Student Awards slide show has been posted to Facebook and the website. Thank you to Ms. Featherman and Ms. Kronlokken for their hard work on that. May 29th HS Graduation in the front parking lot. We will be practicing social distancing and following all guidelines put in place by MDE, MDH and Carver County DOH; There will be LIMITED attendance to adhere to these guidelines. There will be a recessional parade through all 3 towns. Adjusting grading scale for 4th Qtr. has been put into place and a message sent home to parents.

Superintendent's report was given by Tim Schochenmaier.

- 1. Scenarios for next year are being looked at and potential plans are being started (a.) Socially distant classroom learning b.) Continued distance learning in September); Focus groups are looking at Logistics; they are looking at How school will look next year; and how to communicate with families. Any plans made are of course, is pending recommendations and / or restrictions from the CDC.
- 2. Our staff has been using professional development time to become google certified educators. *38 teachers have passed so far *approximately 68%); our goal is to have 100% of staff google certified (if we make that goal; we may be the only district in MN!)
- 3. Guidance from MDH re; summer school and child care. We will be opening fee-based Childcare; there are strict guidelines that MUST be followed in order to do this; Julie K. in Community Ed. Is making sure we meet all 17 bullet points. If we can SAFELY hold summer programs we will; however; there will be A LOT of summer activities cancelled
- 4. Communication Audit in progress. Hoping to report in June.

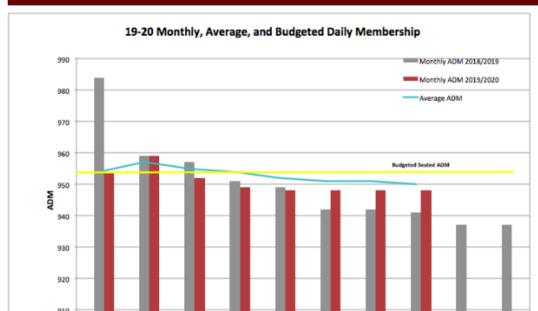
