

Senior Class Activity Updates:

Thursday Night Drive Thru: Thursday night, June 25th, at 5:00 p.m.

The senior drive-thru is this Thursday night, June 25th, at 5:00 p.m. Seniors will start at the Wayland High School and end at the Cohocton Elementary School. I have attached a map of the route that we will take. We will have police escorts. All cars should have their flashers on designating they are part of the group and therefore will hopefully be given right-of-way and be able to stick together as a group.

Students: Please be at the field house parking lot at 4:45 p.m. to get lined up. We leave at 5:00 p.m.! You will need to have someone else driving the car, so that you can watch and wave out the passenger side window! Spectators will be cheering you on from the RIGHT side, so be sure to ride on the passenger side of the car. You may wear your cap if you'd like, but you don't need to wear a gown in the car.

Faculty and Staff: In Wayland, please line up six feet apart near the student banners (they are hanging on the fence). Spread out along that long stretch of road that goes from the high school entrance out to the road (Route 63). In Cohocton, please line up in the bus loop, six feet apart.

Community: Feel free to join us in celebrating our seniors! You may line the sidewalks/streets along our route from Wayland to Cohocton. We will leave the high school at 5:00 p.m.

GRAD BASH: Friday, June 16, 7 to 11 p.m. Cohocton Sports Complex

1. Students must have signed and returned contract/COVID-19 expectations forms. Students may attend if they bring forms with them, but will not be eligible for a prize for submitting paperwork on time. Other prizes will be available for these students.
 2. Grad Bash is from 7-11 p.m. at the Cohocton Sports Complex
 3. Students must be signed in and out by an adult/parent/guardian.
 4. Spectators will not be allowed along the fenceline of the complex. They will be asked to leave the grounds.
 5. Wear your t-shirts/sweatshirts/hats showing your future employment plans, military branch or education plans after high school.
 6. Feel free to bring your yearbooks to get them signed by your peers.
 7. You must adhere to behavior expectations and COVID-19 requirements in order to remain at the event.
 8. Event will be held regardless of weather so come dressed appropriately.
 9. Please remember that this is a community sponsored event and not a school sponsored event, therefore COVID-19 guidelines are different.

GRADUATION: Sunday, June 28th 1 p.m. Field House Parking Lot

Please keep in mind that the graduation ceremony is for all of the seniors and their families. We are asking for respectful behavior in the parking lot, similar to the atmosphere and expected behavior if graduation was in the field house; this is not a tailgate party. There will most likely be people parked behind you whose view will be obstructed if you are hanging out of vehicles. EVERYONE must remain in their vehicles once they have arrived. There is no smoking or use of tobacco products on school grounds, including in vehicles. There is no advantage to arriving early - there are assigned spots, you will be asked to move if you park in a slot not assigned to you.

1. Do NOT get out of your cars.
2. Students must wear a mask when they are outside the vehicle to walk onstage.
3. Students, remember to wear your cap and gown.
4. You MUST have your tickets to get in.
5. Students must sit on the passenger (right) side of the vehicle. They will exit cars and walk up on the stage. A staff member will be there to direct them.
6. Parents/family members wishing to take a picture of the student on stage will also need to sit on the right side of the vehicle. District will provide access to photographs including individual pics of students with diplomas following the ceremony.
7. Bring your own electronic device, a link will be provided, if you wish to watch the live stream. WIFI connection will be available at **WCCS-INTERNET**. The password for that day will be **grad2020**. We are asking that families only access the one device per vehicle to the internet to be certain the internet traffic does not crash the service.
8. We will have people directing traffic and guiding you through the drive-thru process.
9. You must park in the assigned parking spaces; if you are not in the correct space, it will not line up with diplomas, and you'll end up with the wrong one!
10. Bathrooms will be available outside in case of emergency.
11. Only approved vehicles will be allowed into the ceremony. Please be respectful of the space, and remember that you must fit safely into your parking spaces. **All cars should be legally safe and registered for the road and must fit in one standard-sized parking space.** All guests must stay inside vehicles at all times.
