knowledge and practices of scientific reading instruction. The first three courses are scheduled to release in the summer of 2018: the first in June, the second in July, and the third course in August. The remaining courses will release approximately every two months through the spring of 2021. The completion of this Learning Path will fulfill the requirements for an awareness credential for all licensed educators.

The courses will be grouped in the Science of Reading Learning Path for easy access. When logged in, click on the “Courses” tab, and look for “Learning Paths” at the bottom of the left menu. The first course will be available in June.

Memo Number LS-18-090: Science of Reading: Prescribed Pathways for Proficiency or Awareness

Act 1063 of 2017, the Right to Read Act, states: “By the beginning of the 2021-2022 school year: A) All teachers employed in a teaching position that requires an elementary education (K-6) license or special education (K-12) license shall demonstrate proficiency in knowledge and practices of scientific reading instruction; and B) All other teachers shall demonstrate awareness in knowledge and practices of scientific reading instruction.

The Arkansas Department of Education has established the following pathways for teachers who must demonstrate Proficiency or Awareness in scientific reading instruction. The most up to date information related to Arkansas’ implementation of the Prescribed Pathways Credentials, including the attached documents, can be found at www.risarkansas.org.

Prescribed Pathways for Proficiency Credential:

All teachers employed in a teaching position that requires an elementary education (K-6) license or special education (K-12) license shall demonstrate proficiency in knowledge and practices of scientific reading instruction by completing both phases of one of the Prescribed Pathways for

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Language Arts, Math, Science or Social Studies. Other non-core academic areas in K-6 must show awareness in the Science of Reading (e.g., Art, Music, PE, Library Media, Counselor, Administrators).

Phase I outlines professional learning that meets the knowledge and practices in scientific reading instruction approved by the ADE. Phase II provides for demonstration of knowledge and practices in scientific reading instruction.

Districts may submit a request for specific training from an Independent Professional Development (IPD) provider be reviewed by ADE for approval. The district is responsible for submitting all requested information and materials using the IPD Review Form (attached). This is NOT a review of the curriculum program but rather the training program provided for teachers. If an IPD training program is approved, it will be added to the Prescribed Pathways for Proficiency list for the state. Requests will not be accepted directly from a vendor. Prescribed Pathways for Awareness Credential:

All other teachers (e.g., 7-12 Content Specific, Coaches, Library Media Specialists, Career and Technical Education, Counselors, Administrators) shall demonstrate an awareness in knowledge and practices in scientific reading instruction by completing one of the Prescribed Pathways for Awareness (attached).

Memo Number COM-18-054: Clarification on the Computer Science Flex Credit

On April 9, 2015, the Arkansas State Board of Education approved an update to the Standards for Accreditation that created the computer science credit. The Arkansas Department of

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may receive a Computer Science Flex Credit for successful completion of any of the ADE/AR Career ED Approved HS Computer Science courses, which are currently listed at <https://goo.gl/SXciCv>.

Because of this update, a student receiving a Computer Science Flex Credit can substitute that credit in place of the 4th math credit requirement or the 3rd science credit requirement for either Smart Core or Core graduation paths. A student receiving two Computer Science Flex Credits can substitute those credits in place of the 4th math credit requirement and the 3rd science credit requirement for either Smart Core or Core graduation paths.

When calculating a student's graduation eligibility, Triand automatically considers a student's earned credits and makes any appropriate substitutions as necessary. Once a student has met all math and science requirements, any additional non-used computer science credits will be recognized as a career focus credit. Triand business rules have been updated to correctly calculate credits earned for students using Computer Science Flex Credits for math/ science requirements. Schools should notice the update in Triand within the next few weeks.

As the student is receiving a computer science credit in lieu of the math and/or science credit, teachers of record for approved Computer Science courses do not have to hold a mathematics or science certification. The teacher must hold either the 528 Computer Science Endorsement or one of the temporary approval codes. More information on the endorsement and approval codes can be found at <https://goo.gl/pUc9Zk>.

All students must earn one credit in Biology, IB Biology, ADE Biology, ADE Approved Biology Honors, or Concurrent Credit Biology. A student may not use the Computer Science Flex Credit to replace the Biology requirement.

ADE encourages all schools to clearly present the school's computer science offerings on both the school's course catalog and all student course selection worksheets. The school's course catalog and all student course selection worksheets should also clearly indicate that under the ADE Standards for Accreditation that a student may use earned computer science units as Computer Science Flex Credits as outlined above.


