## Kindergarten & New Student Registration 2018-2019

The White Hall School District is excited to announce the following date designed to assist parents and students with a smooth transition from the summer break to the new 2018-2019 school year. A Student "Welcome Back Orientation Day "for elementary parents and students was added to the "*District's 2018-2019 School Calendar*".

On <u>August 10, 2018 from 12:00-6:00</u>, teacher's will "<u>Meet and Greet</u>" their new students and parents. This day is designed for all kindergarten through fifth grade students and parents. This time has been set aside for parents to bring their children to the school to visit their teacher and their classroom prior to the first day of school. Please bring your student's supplies, pay for lunches, complete paperwork and sigh-up for PTO and other school activities. This will be an exciting time for students, parents, and the school. Notification will be sent to parents prior to the orientation date.

All new students, grades Kindergarten thru Fifth (K-5), are required to register at their school attendance site, *Gandy, Hardin, Moody and Taylor, <u>All registration</u> forms must be completed with required information.* 

## Kindergarten and New Student Registration (What You Need to Bring With You)

The kindergarten child must be five (5) <u>on or before **August 1**</u>, **2018**. In order for the school to enroll the child, bring with you an <u>official</u> copy of the following:

- Birth Certificate or <u>one</u> of the following: (US Military ID, a birth affidavit statement by the parent or guardian, local registrar <u>or</u> county recorder certifying the child's date of birth, a Passport, previous School Records, a Baptismal Certificate, Social Security Card)
- Up-to-date Immunization Record: (*immunization record complete with all required shots*)
- Physical Record:: a physical signed by a physician <u>or</u> an official exemption. (kindergarten grade)
- Current Proof of Address: (<u>Proof of address</u> must be current, within the last 30 days, (rent receipt, home ownership papers <u>or</u> lease agreement, etc.); a utility bill to include: gas, water, or electric bill)
- Legal Documents: (Divorce decree, court ordered custody papers, guardianship documents, any other legal documents if applicable).
- Social Security Card
- School Records: (grade transcript <u>or</u> last report card, supplemental program records such as IDEA/IEP) Section 504, Title I-Reading, Title I-Math, etc.)
- Registration must be completed by a parent <u>or</u> guardian. Students will not be enrolled without proper documentation.
