Kindergarten & New Student Registration
Requirements & Procedures
Spring 2019**

The White Hall School District is excited to announce the following date designed to assist parents and students with a smooth transition from Pre-Kindergarten (Day Care) to Kindergarten for the up-coming 2019-2020 school year. On **March 14, 2019** from 3:30-7:30, each school campus in the White Hall School District, Gandy Elementary, Moody Elementary, Taylor Elementary and Hardin Elementary schools will conduct Kindergarten and New Student-to-the-District enrollment.

This date and has been scheduled for parents to enroll their student prior to the first day of school in August. This will be an exciting time for students, parents, and the school. Notification will be sent to parents prior to the registration date.

All new students, grades Kindergarten thru Fifth (K-5), are required to register at their school attendance site, *Gandy Elementary, Hardin Elementary, Moody Elementary and Taylor Elementary.* (All registration forms must be completed.)

Registration Date & Time: March 14, 2019 @ 3:30-7:30.
Kindergarten and New Student Registration
(What You Need to Bring With You)

The Kindergarten child must be five (5) on or before August 1, 2019.

In order for the school to enroll the child, bring with you an *official* copy of the following:

- Birth Certificate or **one** of the following: (1) *US Military ID*, (2) *a birth affidavit statement by the parent or guardian*, (3) *local registrar or county recorder certifying the child's date of birth*, (4) *a Passport, previous School Records*, (5) *a Baptismal Certificate*, (6) *Social Security Card*.
- Up-to-date Immunization Record: (*immunization record complete with all required shots*)
Physical Record: a physical signed by a physician or an official exemption. (*kindergarten grade*)
- Current Proof of Address: (*Proof of address must be current, within the last 30 days, (rent receipt, home ownership papers or lease agreement, etc.); a utility bill to include: gas, water, or electric bill*)
- *Legal Documents: (Divorce decree, court ordered custody papers, guardianship documents, other legal documents if applicable).*
- Social Security Card
- School Records: (*grade transcript or last report card, supplemental program records such as IDEA-IEP, Section 504 Plan, Title I-Reading, Title I-Math, etc.*)
- *Registration must be completed by a parent or guardian.* Students will not be enrolled without proper documentation. For more information contact your child's school office.
