

## South Gibson County High School Scholars' Prep Guide 2019-2020

Course: Clinical Internship

Curriculum for the upcoming course and information of which students should be aware:

Clinical Internship is a capstone course and work-based learning experience designed to provide students with real-world application of skills and knowledge obtained in a pre-requisite Health Science course. Upon completion of this course, proficient students will be able to pursue certification in the pre-requisite course of Cardiovascular Services, Exercise Physiology, Medical Therapeutics or Pharmacological Science. Prior to beginning work at a clinical site, students must be certified in Basic Life Support (BLS) Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), and deemed competent in basic first aid, body mechanics, Standard Precaution

Areas that might be challenging for students:

Clinical Internship is a 4<sup>th</sup> level course for juniors and seniors. This course will rely heavily on skills and concepts learned in previous Health Science courses. Students can only complete Clinical Internship after completing certain Health Science courses. Students will have direct patient contact in Clinical Internship.

Suggestions on how students can prepare for the upcoming course:

Students can prepare for Clinical Internship by reviewing safety material, HIPAA, infection control practices and patient care learned in previous Health Science courses.
