Fashion Design is an applied-knowledge course intended to prepare students to pursue careers in the fashion industry. In addition, students will explore trends in fashion design and engage with industry-specific technologies used to produce a variety of fabrics, Page 2 garments, and accessories. Upon completion of this course, proficient students will have created an original fashion collection.
