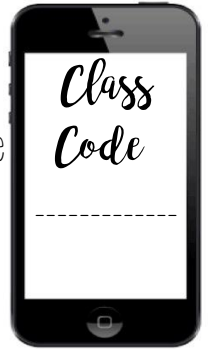

policy for absences & grades

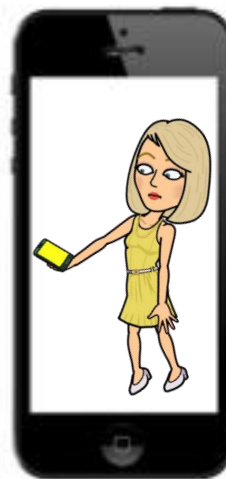
Weekly and daily work will be updated weekly (bell ringers, participation, and quizzes). Please check grades regularly and feel free to ask me any questions that you might have about a particular grade.

If you are absent, **you are responsible for completing your make-up work**. Per school board policy, after returning to school from an absence, you have **5 SCHOOL DAYS** to complete all missing assignments.

All make-up work will be placed in your class' absent folder and your name will be written on any work you missed. It is your responsibility to ask a classmate or me for help on making up any assignments, and/or to meet with Mrs. Cleek to make up any tests, quizzes or papers.

If you know you are going to be absent beforehand, you should ask me for your make-up work before the absence.

This can be done before or after school, during focus time, or via e-mail.



electronic devices
