

QUALIFICATIONS:

- ⇒ High School Diploma or equivalent
- ⇒ 21 years of age minimum
- ⇒ Other requirements as set forth by DeSoto Parish School Board and State of Louisiana



PROCESS

The process to become a school bus driver:

- Eligibility—You must have an acceptable driving record and no criminal record i.e. no felonies. The charge for a background check is \$50.00. Money orders are to be made payable to: DeSoto Parish School Board. No personal checks will be accepted.
- 2. Complete School Bus Driver Training Program. This program consists of 30 hours of classroom training and 10 hours behind the wheel of a school bus.
