Did you know that CAS has its own Learning Garden?

Built entirely by family and community donations and grants, along with volunteer labor, the CAS Learning Garden was first rolled out in Sept. 2015. It's an outdoor interactive classroom used by all 500 students.

We plant organic vegetables and harvest them during the school year, connecting students to their food source and helping them understand the world in a new way.

Students sample their own homegrown organic vegetables including kale, radishes, spinach, lettuce, peas, and many others. They learn about composting, the food chain, insects, nutrition, cooking, and local/organic concepts, among other lessons.
