Before Reading: (5-7 min.)

- Book Introduction: (include meaning, structure, visual)

This book is about a boy who sells a certain kind of hat. Have you ever seen a hat like this one? (Point to a picture of the caps) (Integrate a cultural reason for why a person would wear this kind of hat.) The boy runs into a problem in this story. Let's take a picture walk and see if you can predict what the problem is in the story. Let's read through the story and see if your predictions are correct.

- Difficult Words/Vocabulary: embroidered (p. 4, 8), rustle (p. 10), wearing (p. 11), chattered (p. 11)
- Suggested Teaching Point: (refer to Behaviors to Notice and Support)
Readers slow down to figure out new words.

During Reading: (5-10 min.) *Revisit the teaching point as needed.

Prompts to Support readers: *Does it match?* *Does it sound right?* *Does it make sense?*

After Reading: (5-7 min.)

- Discuss the story
 1. Why did the boy leave the town?
 2. What happened to the boy's hats?
 3. Why do you think the monkeys threw the hats on the ground?
- Return to Teaching Point: Did you have to slow down to figure out any new words? Which words? Did slowing down help you at all?
- Comprehension Strategy Focus: connections, **questions**, **inferences**, visualizing, **summarizing**, synthesizing, determining importance
