Before Reading: (5-7 min.)

- Book Introduction: (include meaning, structure, visual)
 - Have you ever raced?
 - Today we are going to read a story about a car that races.
 - What sometimes happens when you race?
 - When you race sometimes you go to fast at first and end up running out of breath at the end.
 - Have you ever started running too fast at first and then gotten really tired at the end?
- Difficult Words/Vocabulary
 - Thought (2)
 - Careful (12)
 - Enough (12)
- Suggested Teaching Point: (refer to Behaviors to Notice and Support) Readers slow down to figure out new words.

During Reading: (5-10 min.) *Revisit the teaching point as needed.

Prompts to Support readers: Does it match? Does it sound right? Does it make sense?

After Reading: (5-7 min.)

- Discuss the story
 - How was the shiny motorbike acting towards the red bus?
 - How do you think that made the red bus feel?
- Return to Teaching Point
