SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS

It is the Barneveld School Board policy that surveillance cameras are installed and used on school property. Video surveillance shall be used only to promote the order, safety and security of students, staff, visitors and property. A sign will be posted to notify persons utilizing the building of this security measure.

Cameras will be placed only in public areas such as hallways, classrooms, parking lots, entrances, and athletic areas, etc. Cameras shall not be used in private areas such as restrooms, locker rooms, and changing rooms.

Only individuals authorized by the district administrator and/or the building principal may view surveillance recordings. If surveillance recordings become a part of a student disciplinary action, they will become part of that student's record and shall be utilized consistent with the district's student records policy.
