Whereas, the Board is desirous of utilizing the premises known as 129 Madison Avenue, Cresskill, New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as "129 Madison"), 15 Brookside Avenue, Cresskill, New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as "15 Brookside"), and the parcel of land and the building designed as Block 184, Lot 1 and Block 182, Lot 29 on the Borough of Cresskill Tax Map (hereinafter referred to individually as :Parcel" and collectively as "Properties"), attached hereto, as the new facilities that would accommodate the School District's growing need for additional instructional classrooms and administrative offices. The borough of Cresskill (hereinafter referred to as the "Borough") shall purchase the Properties and designate the Parcel as future public school site, for the benefit of the School District, on the borough's master plan, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:60-25.54; and

**Whereas,** the Board is desirous of effectuating the acquisition of the property and the designation of the Parcel as the future public school site on the Borough's master plan, in efforts to alleviate the School District's need for additional facilities and to accommodate the sustained student population growth;

**Whereas**, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., authorizes public entities to enter into a contract with each other to share services which the entities are empowered to provide or receive within their own jurisdictions, including services incidental to the primary purposes of any of the participating public entities; and

**Whereas,** the Board and the borough desire to share the use of the Properties for educational and municipal purposes through a Shared Services Agreement, the terms of which shall be negotiated and determined by the Borough and the Board;

**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved** that the Board hereby approves the Borough of Cresskill's acquisition of the premises known as 129 Madison Avenue, Cresskill, New Jersey, 15 Brookside Avenue, Cresskill, New Jersey, and the parcel of land and the building designated as Block 184, Lot 1 and Block 182, Lot 29 on the Borough of Cresskill Tax Map for the future use as the School District's facilities;
