## **Principal Update**

  school committee.
- Math Pilots first one (Reveal) done, survey was completed. Teachers went through training for Illustrative (second pilot) and will roll out shortly. Pilot is being done in 3 4<sup>th</sup> grade classes and 3 5<sup>th</sup> grade classes – topics are the same as non-pilot classes.

- Loved seeing kids learning, kids love moving around for specials.
