Principal Update (Grenham):

- o Thanks for snacks and lunch at beginning of school teachers very appreciative.

- Scheduling changes/updates:

 - Specials are broken out like middle school schedule allows for students to mix within other classrooms. Feedback has been good.
 - Makers Space and Tech are important part of program/curriculum to keep us as a "21st century school".
 - PIN is scheduled for Thursday night (9/22). Specialists and Makers Space/Tech resources will also be available.
 - Jen Belsky is now overseeing all math specialists at Dale, Wheelock, and Memorial.
 - Lunches are now divided by grade 2 4th grade lunches and 2 5th grade lunches (lunch runs from 11:10am-12:45pm).
- For consideration: Purchase small pumpkins (55 last year) for teachers to paint a scene from their fav book and put them out around school?
 - Action: PTO to discuss/vote.
- For consideration: Seed Science Program run by Liz Bless and Sandy Pearl. Cost is \$7K. Funded last year by Mass Cultural Grant (\$5500) and curriculum funds (~\$1300). Does PTO have any STEM/Architecture resources that would be able to support a grade level program? (Plainville had it funded by grant from local architecture firm).
 - <u>Action</u>: PTO to discuss and provide names/contact information to Steve for outreach.
