The Committee overall rated Dr. Marsden's performance over the past two years as either the high standard of Proficient (3 members) or Exemplary (2 members). Major themes were his overwhelming commitment to not only reinventing how to provide education in an entirely different way and reintegrate students into school from September 2020 on, but the full time commitment that took while performing herculean work with the School Building Committee throughout that time to design a 21st learning environment to the highest standards, regardless of the community's eventual decision to not approve funding for the project. (Amended 3/16/22 to identify that ratings in all areas (3 of 4) indicated that Dr. Marsden's performance should be in the Exemplary Category as indicated above)

AMO: Although I fully understand the importance of this exercise, I believe that limiting Dr. Marsden to a handful of goals truly limits the reality and scope of his overall job, which has been executed with grace under fire during these pandemic years. Based on the metrics in this limited evaluation, he gets an overall proficient grade, but in considering the totality of his performance Dr. Marsden deserves Exemplary

IMG: While many people may reflect back on the first few weeks and/or months of the pandemic as a time when "everything stopped" and perhaps used the "time away" to pick up a new hobby, no such respite existed for a superintendent of schools. In fact, the last two years may be noted as the most challenging time in history to be a Superintendent. Dr. Marsden has worked tirelessly to create a safe

This is a request for the following documents under Open Meeting Law:

1. Draft minutes from the Feb. 10, 2022 Medfield School Committee meeting.
2. A copy of documents associated with the most recent Superintendent Evaluation for Jeffrey Marsden (as discussed on Feb. 10, 2022) used at the Feb. 10, 2022 meeting. Records provided should include both the compiled evaluation and each individual School Committee member evaluation. (See supporting reference below.)

According to an FAQ from Massachusetts Association of School Committees: "Are the evaluations of individual members public? Yes. If the individual evaluations are used in the creation of a composite document, they are considered public records."

MASC also cites MA AGO: "The Open Meeting Law states that 'materials used in a performance evaluation of an individual bearing on his professional competence,' that were created by members of a public body and used during a meeting are public records, and cannot be withheld from public disclosure. See G.L. c. 30A, §22(e). Thus, employee evaluations that members of a public body create and then use during an open meeting to evaluate an employee are public records. Comprehensive evaluations that aggregate the individual public body members' evaluations are also public records if they are used during the course of a meeting." <https://www.mass.gov/info-details/frequently-asked-questions-about-the-open-meeting-law#frequently-asked-questions-about-evaluations->

Excerpts of individual SC member evaluations shared aloud at the meeting and incorporated into the aggregated document deem the individual documents as "used" during the meeting.

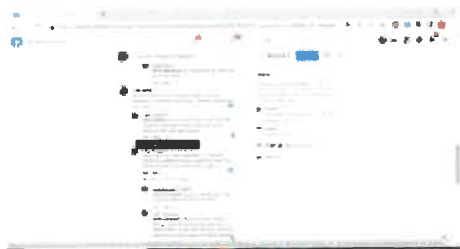

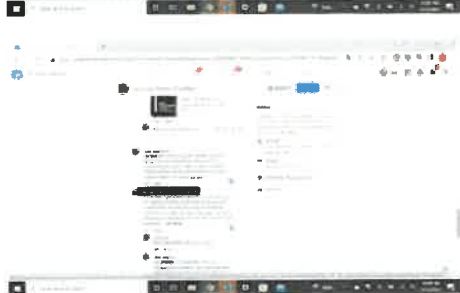
