

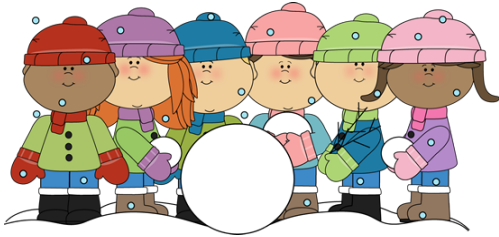

We are busy in the music room.

Kindergarten is finishing *Wearing My Long Winged Feathers*. This is an indigenous piece that was translated to English. The children have learned the song and dance.

They are playing the rattle part (Rattle = Maraca) and they are currently learning the drum part. We are also still working on our train piece and starting the Kindergarten version of *Sneezy the Snowman* which introduces the students to high and low.

Grade One is learning *Charlie Over the Ocean* which is in uneven meter, they are continuing the piece that is coupled with the story, *Room for Everyone*, and is starting the first grade version of *Sneezy the Snowman*.

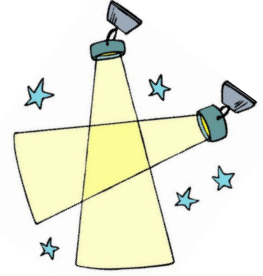

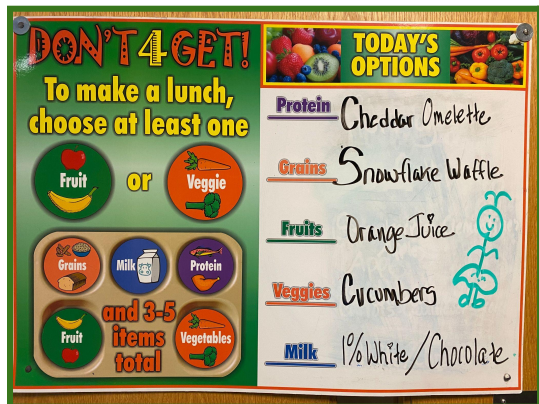

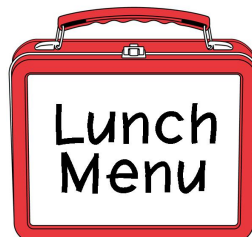
