Required Prom Paperwork

What paperwork/items do you need when you purchase your Prom Ticket(s)?

At the time of purchase you MUST HAVE:

- Your 2019-2020 Analy ID Card
- 'Dance Agreement'
 - *Complete with all signatures*
 - *A separate dance agreement must be completed for prom*

IF YOU ARE BRINGING A GUEST, You must have:

- 'Guest Approval Form' (for students from another school)
 - *Complete with all signature*
- 'In-House Guest Approval Form' (for Analy underclassmen)
 - *Complete with all signatures*
 - *Underclassmen must be with you at the time of ticket purchase, they must also have their student ID card with them.*

Dance Agreement

Analy High School Prom Dance Policy

Dance Rules:

- Analy High School administrators/designees may administer, in a predetermined or random pattern, a breath analysis test to ticket holders upon either entry to the dance or upon reasonable suspicion of student consumptions.
- Dancing styles that include the touching of breasts, buttocks, or genitals or simulates sexual activity is not allowed. When dancing front to back, all dancers must remain upright; NO hands on knees, NO hands on dance floor; both bodies should be able to support their own body weight. See Analy Sexual Harassment Guidelines.
 - Students dancing inappropriately will be warned and their names noted upon 1st offense. On a 2nd offense during the school year, students will be directed to leave the dance floor, their parents/guardians will be contacted, and students will be removed from the dance. Further violations may result in more serious disciplinary actions and students losing the privilege of attending future dances.
- No refunds will be given to any student asked to leave the dance due to violation of these rules.
- For Prom, the dress code is formal: students normally wear longer formal dresses and suits or tuxedos.
- All bags, purses, outerwear, etc. may be searched upon entry to the dance.
- Students may not bring food or drinks into the dance, except with written medical authorization.
 - Appetizers, desserts, and a variety of beverages will be available at the dance.
- **This year's prom is at the Hyatt. The Hyatt has a strict policy regarding booking hotel rooms during prom. Students are NOT ALLOWED to book a room or stay at the hotel, even if a parent books the room, students are not allowed to stay at the hotel.**
- Dance participants may not leave the dance and return. The last time for a dance entry is 1 hour after the start of the dance, 9:00 pm. Students may not leave earlier than 10:30 pm.
